Abstract:

This presentation and workshop will show how a team of five teachers used the concept of disruptive innovation to develop a concept (in this instance a new Project-Based Learning curriculum) that created new value in their institution, by disrupting the existing curriculum (Christensen, 1995). They will share an innovative way to approach language teaching that integrates content and language through a PBL pedagogy. The presentation section will share the challenges related to developing a new interdisciplinary curriculum, teacher identity, teacher agency, and program delivery and how they can be resolved when there is a collaborative and supportive learning community. The workshop session will give participants a hands-on opportunity to use the Project Management Cycle from the Project Management Institute in their PBL classes. This session will be of interest to teachers working in teams, those in curriculum development and those interested in integrating CLIL into their lessons.
